

When Jesus returned to Capernaum after some days, it became known that he was at home. Many gathered together so that there was no longer room for them, not even around the door, and he preached the word to them. They came bringing to him a paralytic carried by four men. Unable to get near Jesus because of the crowd, they opened up the roof above him. After they had broken through, they let down the mat on which the paralytic was lying. When Jesus saw their faith, he said to the paralytic, "Child, your sins are forgiven." Now some of the scribes were sitting there asking themselves, "Why does this man speak that way? He is blaspheming. Who but God alone can forgive sins?" Jesus immediately knew in his mind what they were thinking to themselves, so he said, "Why are you thinking such things in your hearts? Which is easier, to say to the paralytic, 'Your sins are forgiven,' or to say, 'Rise, pick up your mat and walk?' But that you may know that the Son of Man has authority to forgive sins on earth" -he said to the paralytic, "I say to you, rise, pick up your mat, and go home." He rose, picked up his mat at once, and went away in the sight of everyone. They were all astounded and glorified God, saying, "We have never seen anything like this."

## LENT 2012 ~ ASH WEDNESDAY

*This Wednesday, February 22<sup>ND</sup>* the Church begins the forty days and forty nights of Lent.

On Ash Wednesday, you will receive upon your forehead the blessed ash. The blessed ash is made from the blessed palms that were distributed last Palm Sunday. Please bring your blessed palms to church and place them in the basket that is in the vestibule of the church.

### LENTEN DEVOTIONS

The Polish National Catholic Church has not eliminated Lenten Devotions during the Holy Season of Lent. Lenten Services have been eliminated by priests because in their former pastoral experience in other denominations the services were not found to be important to the life of the church, or a lack of spirituality on the part of a congregation and the parish does not support the Lenten Disciple of the PNCC.

### LENTEN "MEAGER MEAL" [DINNER], LENTEN BIBLE STUDY AND LENTEN DEVOTIONS

Beginning Wednesday, March 7<sup>TH</sup> at 6:00 P.M., All Saints will have a weekly Lenten "Meager Meal" with a Lenten Bible Study followed by Lenten Devotions at 7:00 P.M.

The dinner will be a simple meal as we discuss the weekly Lenten Holy Scripture and reflection.

A special Lenten Scripture book and journal has been purchased for the parish to study and reflect on the Scripture and the theme for the Lenten Week.

We will discuss the Lenten theme for the week and the Holy Scripture over dinner.

Sixty books have been purchased for the parish. Please take one, and please consider participating in our Lenten Spiritual Celebration of the Word, Discipline, Liturgy of Lent, Holy Week and Easter.

Lenten Devotions will be celebrated alternating between Stations of the Cross and Bitter Lamentations with Exposition of the Most Blessed Sacrament at both services.

And on Fridays, Stations of the Cross will be celebrated for senior citizens at 3:00 p.m.

Lenten Devotions only takes 45 minutes to 55 minutes to participate in. Jesus hung on the Cross for three hours. He bled, suffocated and died for you. Can you not give Him a few hours during the weeks of the Season of Lent?

### LENTEN ALMSGIVING

All Saints Parish has organized many ways to raise funds to help those who are in need of financial help.

This year we will do what we did last Lent that is to contribute to the "**Poor Box**" that is located in the church vestibule.
